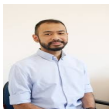

Prompted by the United Nation's 70th anniversary, **debates** have been raised, that the United Nations **have** failed to provide resolutions to the most urgent and important global issues **they** encountered since it **was** founded. **Although** international cooperation **is** the most efficient means to tackle global problems such as man-made climate change and **the** ever-growing gap in **the** quality of **life** between developed and developing countries.

One of the main achievements of the United Nations has certainly been to encourage peace-making efforts by providing a communications platform for countries. As a result, many conflicts have been settled peacefully and the outbreak of a third world war has so far been prevented.

GRAMMATICAL RANGE & ACCURACY: Some problems in the introduction. Tenses are confused and the sentence is too long (see the break introduced with 'However').
